## Summer Reading 2018 - Libraries Rock!

VBDL is ready to rock this summer with an eight-week celebration of books, music, technology, animals, movies, and more books! All readers 2 years and up are encouraged to register at any one of VBDL's seven locations **beginning Monday, June 11.** 

**Summer reading is the best way to prevent "summer slide,**" the tendency for students to lose some of the achievement gains they've made during the school year. Studies show that children who do not read over the summer can fall two years behind by the time they reach fifth grade.

According to the Children's Literacy Initiative, five easy steps can help children avoid summer slide: 1) Go to the library and sign-up for summer reading! 2)

Choose books that challenge and engage, 3) Set realistic goals and develop a reward system, 4) Make it fun!, and 5) Read every day. VBDL offers a sixth tip for adults: Be a reading role model and participate in an adult summer reading program at the library.

**Summer reading is for everyone**, even for those too young to read on their own. The youngest patrons are encouraged to be registered for 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten, a simple, effective program that helps instill a love of reading in infants and toddlers.
