"Expect a lot of community involvement," Children's Librarian Emily Leestma says. "This year's theme is a great inspiration for the library to connect with the local communities in a variety of ways."

Special programs and events, makerspaces, LEGOs, and games are important facets of summer reading, but Leestma says the most important activity during the eight-week program is reading.
