It was moved to accept the Payment of the November 2025 "Due To" vouchers 25-11-01 through 25-11-04 in the amount of \$7,668.02 and general fund vouchers 25-11-02 through 25-11-68 in the amount of \$282,235.17: (Motion: Vliek; Second: Hanson; Motion: Carried).

Unfinished Business:

A. Millage Renewal 2025 Review

The millage passed with high "yes" votes in all service communities. Voting rates for the overall service area was reviewed.

B. Increased Staff Levels For The Branches

Vacant clerk positions at the branches were filled. A second person was hired to fill gaps in Bloomingdale and possibly sub at other locations. A staff member from Webster will be available to sub after the first of the year.

New Business:

A. Branch Library Agreement Addendum

The proposed addendum was reviewed by our attorney. This addendum is required in order for the Library District to legally contribute maintenance funds to the local units who provide branch library facilities. Dan's suggestion is a one-time catch-up payment in 2026 of no more than \$15,000, followed by payments not to exceed \$7,500 annually. The addendum requires the recipient governments to institute a record keeping procedure to ensure the funds are being spent or saved for permitted library purposes under the Library District's establishing law, Public Act 24 of 1989.

It was moved to adopt the Branch Library Addendum, allowing for the Library District to remit to local governments with which it has active Branch Library Agreements, and who also adopt the addendum, a one-time payment in 2026 of no more than \$15,000, followed by payments not to exceed \$7,500 annually, with the insertion of language to clarify how new subsection 3.X of the addendum will be added to current Branch Library Agreements which are in effect. Executive Director Hutchins is authorized to propose the Branch Library Addendum to the governing bodies of local governments with which it has existing Branch Library Agreements; (Motion: Campagna; Second: Rendell Motion: Carried, Voting "yes" – Rendell, Hanson, Cutting, Vliek, Campagna; Voting "no" – no one; Excused Dickerson, Markel; Motion: Carried).

B. End of Year Budget Amendment

It was moved to approve the budget amendments as presented: (Motion: Hanson; Second: Campagna; Motion: Carried, Voting "yes" – Rendell, Hanson, Cutting, Vliek, Campagna; Voting "no" – no one; Excused Dickerson, Markel; Motion: Carried).

C. CIRC-01 Library Card Policy: Amendment for Non-resident Purchase Cards

It was decided the sale of Non-resident Purchased Library Cards will cease immediately. Current Non-resident Purchased Library Card holders will be permitted to retain their purchased card memberships as long as they do not allow them to lapse, keeping their cards up-to-date, in good standing, and paid in full. It was moved to adopt the proposed amendment to the Library Card Policy CIRC-01 ending the sale of Non-resident Purchased Library Cards effective immediately. Executive

D. GOV-05 Contract Community Policy: New

Executive Director Hutchins proposed a new policy which would establish a minimum annual fee to provide library services to contracting communities outside of VBDL’s service area. After discussion, it was decided not to adopt the proposed policy, but rather to end the contract agreement to provide library service to Geneva Twp. at the conclusion of the current contract year, June 30, 2026.

E. Adjustment of Open Hours For Webster Memorial & Covert Branch Libraries

Motion to adjust Webster Memorial Library’s hours from closing at 8:00 P.M. Monday through Thursday evenings to closing at 7:00 P.M. Monday through Thursday evenings, and to further adjust Covert Branch Library’s Thursday afternoon closing time from 6:00 P.M. on Thursdays to 5:00 P.M. on Thursdays. The effective dates of these amended hours are left to the discretion of Executive Director Hutchins: (Motion: Hanson; Second: Campagna; Motion: Carried).

F. Additional Paycheck For Laura Dorgelo

In recognition of the additional work she took on to help disseminate informational materials beyond her assigned duties as Bloomingdale Branch Library’s Manager, it was moved to provide Laura Dorgelo with an additional paycheck for 2025, with the Library District paying all applicable tax liabilities:
